

**Two Attendance Grants Awarded to Two District 5160 Rotary Clubs  
for the House of Friendship at the Rotary International Convention  
Houston, Texas June 4 - 8, 2022**

The District 5160 Budget for 2021-2022 included \$3000.00 to fund Project Fair Attendance Grants, intended to help clubs send members to Project Fairs. However, because of COVID, Project Fairs in 2021-22 were either virtual or postponed.

Therefore, the District allotted the \$3000.00 to fund grants of \$1500.00 each to two clubs to be used as stipends to help member(s) attend the House of Friendship at the Rotary International Convention in Houston, Texas June 4 - 8, 2022. Eligible Expenses were Registration, Transportation, Accommodations, and Meals.

The goal in sending members to the House of Friendship was to identify potential projects that may be relevant to some of our clubs, to establish relationships that might lead to collaborative projects, and to report to clubs at meetings, District events, in articles, and other means.

Six clubs submitted applications: Berkeley, Davis Sunrise, Hercules, Mt. Shasta, Redding West, and San Ramon. The District International Service Committee carefully evaluated, scored, and ranked each application. At the Spring Assemblies on April 23, 2022 and May 7, 2022, they announced that two Grants of \$1500.00 each were awarded to two eligible District Clubs:

1. The Rotary Club of Davis Sunrise that selected Irena Asmundson to attend
2. The Rotary Club of Mt. Shasta that selected Carolyn Briody to attend
